Goal

Point 3.2 of the VCA checklist demands that all operational personnel should follow a VCA safety training . The VCA/SCC for operational supervisors training offers an overview of basic knowledge on a whole range of risks and preventive measures.

Candidates

- Minimum 18 years old
- Medical aptitude

Content of the training

- Work permits
- Legislation-responsibility of an operator
- Use of PPE
- Risks and dangers of working with a gantry crane
- Several types of gantry cranes
- Types of lifting and rigging equipment
- Implementing the safety rules
- Use of a gantry crane
- Signs
- Daily inspections

Documentation

A paper syllabus is given with the content of the training per candidate. When the candidate passes the examination, a 10 year valid VCA certificate is given.

Languages

The training as the examination is possible in several languages. Common languages are : Dutch, French, English. Other languages upon request and possibility

Duration

1 day training. From 8h30 till 16h with a lunch break, ½ day theory and ½ day practical training

Examination

The examination is done by a theoretical and practical test at the end of the training
