

## BA5 training

'Competent personnel' – working safely in electric installations

### Goal

This training has an aim to inform the candidates on the risks and dangers of working in an environment with electrical hazards. In a way so they can :

- Identify electrical risks
- Motivated to make use of personal protective equipment and work in a correct manner
- Able to execute a risk analysis in an electric installation
- Able to work in an electric installation

### Candidates

Need to have a form of training on working in an electric installation f.ex trained as electrician or engineer into electric related science

### Content of the training

- Legislation
- Risks and preventive measures
- Accidents and incidents
- Work permits
- BA4/BA5 codifications
- Fire and explosions
- Protection techniques
- Installations
- Personal Protective Equipment/Collective Protective Equipment
- Risk analysis in an electric installation
- Signalization
- Working in an electric installation

### Documentation

A paper syllabus is given with the content of the training per candidate. When the candidate passes the examination, a 5 year valid certificate is given.

### Languages

The training as the examination is possible in several languages. Common languages are : Dutch, French and English. Other languages upon request and possibility (extra costs)

### Duration

2 day training. From 9h00 till 16h00 with a lunch break (1/2 day practical training)

### Examination

At the end of the training there's a small examination on the content of the given course. 60% is a minimum to obtain the certificate.
